

# Danish Open - Melges 24

## 1 RULES

### 1.1

The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the [Racing Rules of Sailing](#), except as changed by the sailing instructions.

### 1.2

The applying prescriptions of the Nordic Sailing Federation and the Danish Sailing Association will be incorporated into the sailing instructions.

## 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

### 2.1

The regatta is open for Melges 24. The minimum number of entrants in the class is 5. Participants must comply with the eligibility prescriptions in their Class Rules.

### 2.2

Eligible boats may enter no later than August 1. by sending an email to [kattedgat@os.dk](mailto:kattedgat@os.dk) with the following information: sail number, name, email, phone number and club for helmsman and name/club for other crew members.

Furthermore, Danish participants must pay the entry fee (see 3) to Jyske Bank reg.: 5071 account: 0001226659. The entry will not be accepted before the entry fee is received.

Foreign entrants may pay in cash (Euro or DKK) at registration in Frederikshavn.

Please mark all emails and the bank notice with "sail no".

### 2.3

Late entries will be accepted against an additional entry fee of DKK 150 (Euro 20).

## 3. ENTRY FEE

DKK 750 (Euro 100) - Late entry (after 1 August): Plus DKK 150 (Euro 20)

Dinner Friday DKK. 60 (Euro 8)

Breakfast/lunch each morning/day DKK 65 (Euro 8.5)

Dinner Saturday DKK 180 (Euro 24)

The entry fee includes bar/snack after the races.

Rent a caravan 8 available DKK 800 ( Euro108) Friday-Sunday

## 4. SCHEDULE OF RACES

### 4.1

#### Registration:

All boats: Thursday 21 August 16.00 - 21.00 and Friday 22 August 7.30 – 10.00.

At the regatta office in the club house – ground floor south end, right across from the crane.

### 4.2

#### Sailing:

A total of 8 races are planned for the regatta, with a preliminary plan of ‘

2-3 races Friday

3-4 races Saturday

2 races Sunday.

#### 4.3

The first warning signal for the first race on Friday: 13.00

The first warning signal for the first race on Saturday: 10.00

The first warning signal for the first race on Sunday: 10.00

After finishing a race a new race will be started soonest possible after the finish.

#### 4.4

On the Sunday no warning signal will be made later than 14.00

## 5 MEASUREMENT

Each boat must be able to produce a valid class or measurement certificate at any time.

## 6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

## 7 VENUES

#### 7.1

The regatta harbor will be Frederikshavn Marina, Søsportsvej 14, 9900 Frederikshavn, Denmark

#### 7.2

Courses will be sailed on the waters near Frederikshavn Marina.

## 8 THE COURSE

The courses will be "windward/Leeward courses".

The planned sailing time for the first boat is approx 60 minutes for Melges 24.

## 9 SCORING

#### 9.1

There is planned 8 races

#### 9.2

When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

When from five to eight races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## 10 BERTHING

The boats must be placed on the assigned places. Instructions from club officials or from the harbor master must be followed.

## 11 Haulout restrictions

Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta from 09.30 hrs. on the first racing day until the last boat finishes the last race, except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

## 13 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded on a ratio of one per each five boats. Prize giving will take place soonest possible after racing on the Sunday.

## 14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## 15 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance. Documentation must be presented when required at any time.
